- A legal editor as coordinator



Content management in French local administrations

- French *communes* (municipalities)
 - The *commune* is the smallest level of administrative division
 - The 36,000 *communes* have a large set of competencies
 - education, youth and schools, roads, urbanism, cultural action
 - social welfare, vital records
 - Small *communes* have a very limited staff (1 town clerk)
- Content management issues
 - Keep citizens informed of new decisions and regulatory changes
 - Harmonize local law and decisions across neighboring municipalities and different levels of administration
 - Enhance the quality of local acts
 - 15 to 20 % of the contested acts are canceled for formal reasons

The Légilocal platform

Unifying the content management processes and the interactions between actors on the contents

■ Functionalities

- Assisting clerks in the drafting and publication of local acts
- Providing semantic search facilities to citizens

■ Design choices

- The platform must be easily accessible
 - to clerks *via* a professional social network
 - to citizens *via* widgets embedded in municipal websites
- It must be tested on a pilot group of municipalities
- It must be progressively deployed in small French municipalities

The Légilocal platform

- 3 types of users
- Tools
 - Semantic content management
 - Resource management system
 - Annotator
 - Search engine
 - Interaction
 - Network management system
 - People search & chat system
 - External tools: text editor, websites
- Resources
 - Administrative acts
 - Editorial document
 - Semantic vocabularies
 - Document model







- Editorial resources: document templates, guidelines, external legal resources
- Semantic resources for document annotation



Use case

■ Settings

- a fictitious municipality (Abirée) and its administrator (Mrs. Irène Proust)
- Mrs. Proust has to publish a new *arrêté* (bylaw) related to 4-wheel drive vehicles, which use on the municipal roads will be prohibited

■ Mrs. Proust connects herself to REZODAC to get some help



Drafting a document

- Mrs. Proust decides to search for documents rather than for experts
query "véhicule chemin" (vehicle AND trails)
- The systems returns some related documents
 - already published acts, legislative texts
 - editorial documents (e.g. feature articles or news)
 - comments posted on REZODAC
- Mrs. Proust selects a document in REZODAC, edits it and adapts it to her needs
 - An *arrêté* uploaded by another clerk of her network
 - It is similar to the one she has to produce
 - It is a word document

Publishing a document on REZODAC

When her document is ready, Mrs. Proust

- presses the "New act" button in her interface
- associates some metadata to her document (e.g. the type of act, keywords)
- uploads the draft document
- adds a comment "to be reviewed before publication, thanks"

The new document is

- automatically enriched with semantic information
 - status, locations, author, themes, references to legislation
- posted in the group "Mairie d'Abirée"


Final validation and publication

■ Validation

- The mayor of Abirée is notified through REZODAC that a draft act has been published
- He looks at the document and validates it
 - button 'Reviewed and validated'
- Mrs.Proust is notified through REZODAC that her document has been validated

■ Official publication

- Mrs.Proust presses the button 'Publish'
- She fills the fields required by the final web publication
 - e.g. **official date**
- She clicks on the "OK" button



Result

- A PDF version of the *arrêté* is automatically created with the requested metadata
- The new Mairie d'Abirée *arrêté* is accessible to the REZODAC members
- It is posted on the website of Mairie d'Abirée

a challenging use case for integrating collaborative and semantic technologies

a simple, interactive and viral approach of content management

- Design & development
 - Tools development and platform integration
 - The Légilocal editor sets up the platform
- Test & evaluation
 - User tests on a pilot group of municipalities and a specific use case
 - No scientific evaluation
- Deployment: Clerks progressively join the network
 - Clerks have access to the various Légilocal facilities
 - The base of administrative acts grows
 - Clerks get connected to more peers
- Further development on semantic analysis
 - Adding new editorial documents
 - Enriching the semantic resources (citizens vs. administrative languages)
 - Controlling the document legality
